The entry fee includes clays, shells, and a golf cart for four shooters. If you have your own golf cart it is permissible to bring it to use at the event. Shotguns are available for rent from Blackjack the day of the event (limited quantity). Blackjack also has RV parking onsite at no charge, self-contained only.

Florida Elks Charities is looking forward to a day of great competition, fun and friendship. After you complete the regular tournament course, there will be a unique competition on a 5-tier station tower. For just a \$125.00 entry fee you can compete to win a 50/50 split of the entry fees (less the cost) for this add-on event with Florida Elks Charities (limited to 25 participants). We will gather at the Blackjack Pavilion for a bar-b-que lunch and cold drinks and there will be prizes awarded to the top 3 teams along with the male and female shooter with the highest score. Expect many other opportunities to win awesome prizes.
